Campers will explore choreography, musical theater presentation and vocal production as they participate in one large group number and small group numbers. Musical direction and individual voice lessons by Dan Bruce (younger campers may have small group voice lessons). At 5:00 p.m. on the last day of camp students will take part in a low-stress presentation for families.
