<u>The Fairy Tree of Dooros</u> February 24 (M) – February 28 (F) Ages: K-6 grade, Counselor in Training ages 14-16 Cost: \$360 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. (Thursday, February 27 performance at 4 p.m.) Minimum participants: 15

In the heart of a secret Irish forest grows a special tree with magical berries. When a clumsy little fairy named Pinkeen accidentally drops a berry into the human world, he must embark on a quest to find a guardian for the tree. Along the way, we meet Sharvan the giant, a cursed princess named Rosaleen, and her loyal friend Robin the bird. But when Nemo is captured and taken to Sydney, Marlin sets off on an adventure across the ocean. With the help of lovable characters such as Dory, Crush, and the supportive Tank Gang, Marlin and Nemo both overcome challenges on their journey to find each other and themselves.

During this two week camp, students will work toward mounting a full musical performance! The ghost-with-the-most comes to the stage in *Beetlejuice JR.*, the frightfully funny musical based on the beloved motion picture turned Broadway phenomenon. Lydia Deetz is a strange and unusual teenager, still grieving the loss of her mother and obsessed with the whole "being dead thing." Lucky for Lydia, she and her father move to a new house haunted by a recently deceased couple and Beetlejuice, a delightful demon with a real zest for life. When Lydia calls on Beetlejuice to scare away anyone with a pulse, this double-crossing specter shows his true stripes, unleashing a (Nether)world of pandemonium. Performances will be the evening of Friday, August 8th and a matinee Saturday, August 9th.
